

Rock 'n' Roll History with Dr. Joel Keller: Four educational sessions dealing with Rock and Roll music.

The first will detail the early days, including examples of the types of music that melded together to form Rock and Roll. Then, some of the top 10 hits starting with 1949 and ending with 1964 will be played and information about the artists and groups will be discussed.

The second course will cover the first "British Invasion" from the Beatles' appearance on the Ed Sullivan show until the end of that era in 1967. Hear some of the works of artists alphabetically from the Animals to the Zombies.

The third course will introduce "Progressive Rock" groups and artists as well as popular musicians from the 1970's, including Billy Joel, Elton John, John Denver and others.

In the fourth class, learn about the importance of music in "non-musical" movies, following the evolution of sound tracks from the silent movie era through the current day and listen to a selection of music and view scenes from many current movies. These tracks will include some musicals but mostly non-musical movies.
