Thanks to a new program piloted by the Greater Cleveland Food Bank, eligible older adult residents of South Euclid, Lyndhurst, Highland Heights, Mayfield Heights and Mayfield Village (residents of cities other than those listed may reserve a tote provided they have attended programs or events through Community Partnership on Aging in the past year) can receive a free To-Go Tote of groceries through Community Partnership on Aging!

Those interested in receiving a Fresh Goods To Go Tote are required to call in for a reservation to the Community Partnership on Aging program phone line, at 216-650-4029. You will be asked to provide ID and to complete a short registration form on the distribution day when you pick up your To-Go Tote. One Tote per household.

Program Eligibility

You are considered eligible for the program if your income falls within the limits on the chart below. At the time of pick-up, you will be required to present identification as well as complete a registration form which includes a signed statement certifying your income meets the program guidelines.
